THE RELATIONSHIP BETWEEN GUNS AND  
VIOLENCE IS FAR FROM SIMPLE.  
YET STUDIES INDICATE THAT IN CERTAIN  
CIRCUMSTANCES... GUN LAWS HAVE SAVED  
LIVES.  
FOR INSTANCE... WASHINGTON, D. C. 'S BAN  
ON HANDGUN SALES.

AND OVERALL... THE RATES OF HOMICIDE  
AND SUICIDE COMMITTED BY OTHER MEANS

ESTIMATE 47 LIVES WERE SAVED A YEAR.  
UNFORTUNATELY... AFTER CRACK HIT THE  
STREETS... VIOLENT DEATH RATES SHOT UP.
